← BEFORE THE EVENT

(now is a great time!)

It is very important that you know the email address that was used to reserve your ticket to the event. You MUST logon with that email address to get access. You can find that by looking at the email you received when you were registered that came from Accelevents. (NOTE: when you registered you were instructed to provide unique names and email addresses for every ticket you purchased. Some people bought several with one name and one email address. This prevents personalization of everyone's portal, but if you may have a number of logins to that email address equal to the number of tickets you purchased with that email address. Some functionality will be reduced since unique email addresses were not given when registering)





You will then be taken to the event page. It should initiate a pop-up window in your browser for you to create a log-in. Enter the email address from your registration and create a password. You should be good to go after that.


NOTE: Some browsers aren't initiating the pop-up window (you may have it blocked in your browser). In that case, at the top right of the event page, click on "Sign-Up."



Enter your email address from registration and a password of your choice. DO NOT LOGIN WITH FACEBOOK.




Once you log in, your name (as provided at registration) will appear in the top right:



You now look through the classes on the site and can star classes you are interested in to help you narrow down the choices, or you can register by clicking the REGISTER button.

If you think you want to attend a particular class, you can click the REGISTER button:






↓ THE DAY OF THE EVENT

Enter the event

- Access the event page on your browser. You can check the confirmation email that is sent to you and click the **View Event Details** button to be redirected to the event page
- Click the **Enter** button to enter the virtual event hub. The button should be visible 30 minutes before the start of the first session (9:00 AM EDT)
- Enter the email address you used to register and enter your password, then click **Submit**. If it's your first time to log in, just create a password. You should be redirected to the virtual event hub.
- Note: If after logging in, it does not redirect you to the virtual event hub, just click the Enter Event button again

Once you are in to the event hub you will see this screen:




Take note of the menu on the left sidebar:


STAGE



SESSIONS

This is where you go to the virtual room where your class will be held. Just click on the SESSIONS tab on the left sidebar. There are many classes to choose from. This is why it is good to logon days before to select your choices ahead of time. Realize all classes will be archived for you to see up to 90 days after the event.



Just click on the class you want to enter, and it will take you to the virtual classroom.




If there are **resources** (handouts, slides, etc.) to download, look in the description of the class for a link to a Google folder with resources. If the instructor is teaching more than one class, ALL of the resources are in that folder, so be sure to select the one for the class you are attending.

On the right side is a chat window. Most of our classes will not have chat with the instructor, but classmates can use chat, if needed.

NETWORKING

Ten minutes before each of our main sessions, you will have opportunity to meet up to 21 people attending the event at random. You will have 20 seconds to introduce yourselves to each other, then after 20 seconds, you will be face-to-face with another person. This will give you a better feel for the people attending the conference—more of a social interaction that is often lacking in virtual events.

Just click the NETWORKING tab on the left sidebar to go there.






If you want to talk with the rep, go to the bottom and click on the chat icon, or schedule a time to talk on the calendar icon:

PEOPLE




If you see someone you want to connect with, click the connect button.




The button will change to a SENT button to let you know the other party has been notified.




On the person's hub that you wanted to connect with, they will receive a notification of the potential meeting:
